

Case Log Instructions: Pediatric Cardiac Anesthesiology Review Committee for Anesthesiology

Background

The ACGME Case Log System helps assess the breadth and depth of the clinical experience provided to fellows by a pediatric cardiac anesthesiology fellowship. It is the responsibility of the fellows to enter their case data accurately and in a timely manner, and the responsibility of the program director to ensure fellows' Case Logs are accurate.

Fellows are required to log cases in the ACGME Case Log System beginning July 1, 2022.

Common Case Log System Questions

Are fellows required to enter cases into the Case Log System? Yes, logging is required as of July 1, 2022.

How do fellows get an ID and password to access the Case Log System?

New fellows will have an ID and password assigned and emailed to them when their information is first entered into the ACGME's Accreditation Data System (ADS) by the program director or coordinator. For fellows who were in the program prior to the Case Log application, program directors or coordinators should go to the Fellow Roster in ADS and click "Grant User." This will create and email IDs and passwords to existing fellows. In either case, fellows will be required to change their passwords the first time they log into the system.

Can the program director and coordinator access the Case Log System?

Yes. Program directors and coordinators can access the system in a "view only" mode. In ADS, go to Case Logs > Cases > Entry (View Only). Information can be entered but not saved.

Can fellows log procedures that are not being tracked in the Case Log System?

Fellows are only required to log those experiences the Review Committee is tracking (see previous pages for details). However, programs and/or fellows may use the system to track other procedures for their own purposes.

Can a program receive a citation based on Case Log data?

If a program's Case Log data indicate fellows are not consistently and/or accurately logging their experiences, the Review Committee may issue a citation or AFI regarding program director oversight of fellows' Case Logs.
