About the project:

The project focused on educational outcomes and advancing humanism in patient care by creating a curriculum to improve residents' skills in managing medical complexity.

Residents led the initiative, with training on G-tube and tracheostomy care. The project resulted in significant improvements in residents' confidence. It addressed gaps in [intellectual and developmental disabilities] education and is designed to be sustainable by integrating into residency curricula and collaborating with advocacy groups. The model is replicable for other programs.

"Dr. Schoenberger has repeatedly demonstrated commitment and advocacy for vulnerable populations living with intellectual and developmental disabilities who frequently face discrimination and challenges throughout their lifespan.
